Sir/Madam,

In pursuant to the Letter of Intent dated 16th March 2013 a personal hearing was granted to the Institute authority to present before the Board of Governors with written submission. The Institute did not appear for personal hearing on 21st March 2013.

The Board of Governors after due consideration and scrutiny of additional documents submitted along with review of assessment report and taking into consideration verbal explanation, decided to reiterate their earlier decision and issue Conditional Letter of Permission for Increase of seats in MD(Anaesthesia) course from 06(Six) to 08(Eight) seats per year. This decision is subject to submission of blood component license issued by the competent authority to the Council.

This Conditional Letter of Permission is subject to fulfillment of the following conditions:-

1. The applicant should provide all infrastructural facilities in terms of teaching and non-teaching staff, buildings, equipment and hospital facilities as per Medical Council of India norms. I am further directed to inform that you and your institution are fully responsible to fulfill and maintain norms including the infrastructure both physical and human resource, teaching faculty and clinical material, etc. throughout the academic year, as stipulated in Postgraduate Regulation of Medical Council of India. In case false/wrong declaration or fabricated documents have been used for procuring permission of the Board of Governors for the starting/increased intake and the said misconduct is brought to notice or comes to the knowledge of Medical Council of India at any stage during the current academic year, your institution is not liable to be considered for increased intake for the next academic year and this letter of permission for the increased intake/starting is also liable to be revoked for current academic year. Besides, Medical Council of India is entitled to take all such measures against you and your college/institution as permissible under the law.
2. Other deficiencies if any pointed out in the inspection report should be rectified. A copy of MCI inspection report is enclosed.
3. No student should be admitted in the above courses till the formal permission of the Board of Governors is granted.
4. The applicant should provide Bank Guarantee of required amount wherever required in favour of Secretary, Medical Council of India, New Delhi valid for three years from a nationalized/scheduled Bank as per MCI's norms against increased intake/starting of above said course. However, Bank guarantee is not applicable for Government institution.
5. The college has to give an undertaking that the students admitted to this course shall be paid stipend on par with the stipend being paid to the Postgraduate students of State Government Medical Institutes/Central Government Medical Institutions, in the State/Union Territory where the institution is located as required under Clause 13.3 of the Postgraduate Medical Regulations.

Postgraduate students admitted to this course would be required to present one poster presentation to read one paper at a national/state conference and to present one research paper which should be published/accepted for publication/sent for publication during the period of his Postgraduate studies so as to make him eligible to appear at the Postgraduate degree examination as prescribed in the Postgraduate Medical Education Regulations notified vide Gazette Notification dated 09/12/2009 (Clause 13.9).

As per Postgraduate Medical Education Regulations under Clause 14.(4)(a) it has been prescribed that "Every candidate shall carry out work on an assigned research project under the guidance of a recognized Post Graduate Teacher, the result of which shall be written up and submitted in the form of a Thesis. The thesis shall be examined by a minimum of three examiners; one internal and two external examiners, who shall not be the examiners for Theory and Clinical examination. A candidate shall be allowed to appear for the Theory and Practical/Clinical examination only after the acceptance of the Thesis by the examiners."

8. The Medical college while making admission to the course shall ensure that:-
- No admission is permitted beyond the sanctioned intake capacity.
  - Selection of students to the Medical College is in accordance with the requirements laid down in the Postgraduate Medical Education Regulations, 2000.
  - No admission is permitted beyond the cutoff date

It shall be incumbent upon the Medical College that the information relating to admission should be submitted within a fortnight of closure of admission to the Council. Any failure to submit the information within this time limit would be construed that the admission in the College were not in accordance with the statutory requirements, thereby enabling the Council to proceed in accordance with law against the college.

You are requested to send compliance to above mentioned conditions including bank guarantee as required under the Regulations of Medical Council of India within **15 (Fifteen) days** of issue of this letter failing which the Letter of Permission issued for Increase of seats in the above course shall stand cancelled which shall result in forfeiture of right of the college/institution to admit the students in the above course.

The college authorities shall take up the matter for recognition of the qualification under section 11(2) of the IMC Act at the time of first batch admitted against the course appears for final year examination.

- OPD has only 2 examination rooms against requirement of 4 examination rooms. There is no separate area for demonstration or for teaching in OPD.
- Patient load in OPD on day of assessment was very low. Average daily OPD is 80, which is inadequate.
- Paediatrics related workload in ancillary departments like Radiodiagnosis, Microbiology, Pathology & Biochemistry is low.
- NICU: There is no concept of temperature maintenance with all radiant warmers switched off. There was misutilization of equipment. Ventilator was nonfunctional.
- Library is in poor state. Books available are very old with obsolete information. No budget has been earmarked for last 3 years. No specialty journals are available. Computers in a section were mostly not functional.
- There are no publications from the department in indexed journals in last 3 years.
- Medical records are not computerized.
- Other deficiencies as pointed out in the Assessment Report.

You are requested to rectify the above deficiencies at the earliest and submit the compliance for consideration in the matter.



- All Medical Colleges to maintain the attendance electronically/physical register in each department/section which must be signed by the faculty/residents/other functionaries by 9:30 am (within half an hour of commencement of duty).
- The electronic data/physical attendance register, after verification and signature by the HOD/HOS, should reach the office of Principal/Dean/Director of the institute by 10 am (within one hour of commencement of duty) regularly.
- Dean should check these data/registers and sign the same, making note of absentees and/or faculty/residents on leave.
- In the case of physical attendance registers, the same should remain in the office of Principal/Dean/Director of the institute till 11:30 am, after which these registers should be collected by the respective departments.
- These electronic data sheet/physical attendance registers shall be made available to the assessors during the time of inspection. The assessors should check the Declaration Forms along with faculty members at either 11 am or 4 pm or when they visit various departments, without causing any hindrance in the functioning of the college and the hospital.

In addition to above, it has also been directed by the Oversight Committee to complete the exercise, latest by October, 10, 2016:-

- Website:** It should be a comprehensive website depicting the medical college and the college website should necessarily be updated in the first week of every month and a copy of the content should be preserved and a copy be submitted to MCI for updation on the MCI website. The college website should, inter alia display:
  - Faculty:** The information about every faculty member should be available on the website of the college and should include the designations/promotions/transfers/resignations/joining and the required IMR details. Names of the faculty member not display on the website would not be counted during the assessment process. Wrongly displayed names or names of faculty appearing on website of another institution would be dealt with as per existing Regulations.
  - The Faculty web-link should display the faculty attendance. A record of the same should be available electronically or in the form of a register in each department/section which must be recorded/signed by faculty in-charge/Dean/Principal.
  - Monthly schedule of teaching should be displayed on the website of the college depicting the name of the teacher and the lecture/demonstration topic with the date and time. A minimum of 70% lectures of the scheduled lectures must be taken by the respective faculty.
  - Data of every undergraduate medical student/post-graduate should be uploaded on the college website and submitted to the MCI for inclusion in the MCI website. The data for the UG course should include, the NEET score of the student, the date of admission to the college and the fee charged by the college for admission. The student information should

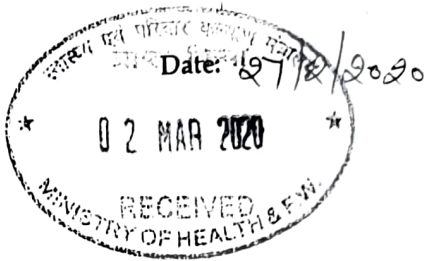

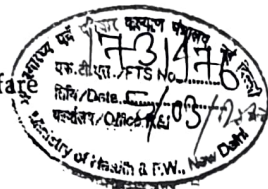

Subject: Implementation of 10% EWS quota in PG courses in Government Medical Colleges for the academic year 2020-21.

Sir,

In order to implement 10% EWS quota in PG medical courses in the State quota in Government Medical Colleges/institutions, the States were required to enhance PG medical seats for the AY 2020-21 and observed that most states had increased their PG seats in Government medical colleges for 2020-21 either by way of applications made to MCI under section 10/A and/or by way of conversion of denotified diploma seats to degree seats.

2. As noted from the table below the States of Assam, Bihar, Chattisgarh, Goa, Jharkhand, Kerala, Madhya Pradesh, Maharashtra, Puducherry, Telengana, Tripura, Uttar Pradesh, Uttarakhand and West Bengal had more increase in seats than the seats required to be enhanced for implementing 10% EWS quota. These states have been informed to implement the reservation roster, including the EWS quota as per State policy after including the seats enhanced during the AY 2020-21 since they had been granted adequate increase in seats for the same.

However, in the States of Andhra Pradesh, Gujarat, Haryana, Odisha and Rajasthan the seats increased under 10/A and/or after conversion of diplomas to degree for the AY 2020-21 was less than the number of seats needed to be enhanced for implementing 10% EWS quota. In addition there were no applications for increase under 10/A or for conversion of diplomas to degree from the Government medical colleges from the States of Himachal Pradesh, Punjab and the UT of Chandigarh. The status of increase in the above mentioned 8 States is provided in the table below. Further it may be noted that no applications were received for EWS seat enhancement from the States of Delhi, Karnataka, Tamil Nadu, Manipur and Meghalaya.

4. The Governments of Andhra Pradesh, Chandigarh, Gujarat, Haryana, Himachal Pradesh, Odisha, Punjab and, Rajasthan were requested to send their specific proposals for increase in PG medical seats in those PG courses in which they had not applied for increase in seats under 10/A for AY 2020-21, but had the potential to increase seats in accordance with the PGMER 2000 regulations so as to enable them to meet the required seat enhancement for implementing 10% EWS quota. It may be appreciated that no seats can be granted without requisite faculty because a PG student requires guidance from faculty for completion of the thesis, therefore, availability of requisite faculty has been carefully considered while granting additional seats within PGMER. DME of these states are also fully aware of the capacity of their colleges for PG courses. Proposals were received from the States of Andhra Pradesh, Chandigarh Gujarat, Himachal Pradesh, Punjab and Rajasthan. The Board of Governors, Medical Council of India, considered the proposals of the State Governments and approved the proposals that were in conformity with the PGMER regulations. No proposal was received from Government of Haryana and Odisha. A total of 145 seats were additionally approved in the 6 above mentioned states (Andhra Pradesh 6, Chandigarh 4, Gujarat 56, Himachal Pradesh 7, Punjab 17, Rajasthan 51). The details of State wise seats approved in various PG courses are Annexed.

The Teaching Institutions are advised to apply for recognition of the qualification at the time of first available examination as per the provision of Section 11(2) of the IMC Act, 1956 in respect of these enhanced seats made available to them for implementation of EWS quota.

I am to state that the General Body of this council at its meeting held on 26-27/03/2015 considered the Council assessor report (June, 2014) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at Indira Gandhi Medical College, Shimla for purpose of Recognition of MD/MS(Ophthalmology) qualification against increased intake from 02 to 04 seats granted by Himachal Pradesh University.

The Council approved the following recommendations of the Postgraduate Committee, which I am directed to convey herewith for your information and necessary action:-

"The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee considered the Assessment Report (June, 2014) and decided to recommend that MD/MS(Ophthalmology) qualification against increased intake from 02 to 04 seats granted by Himachal Pradesh University in respect of students being trained at Indira Gandhi Medical College, Shimla be recognized and included in the 1st Schedule to the I.M.C. Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee further decided that the recognition so granted shall be for a maximum period of 5 years from the date of Notification upon which the Institute shall have to apply for renewal of recognition. Failure to seek timely renewal of recognition as required shall invariably result in stoppage of admission to the Postgraduate Course."
